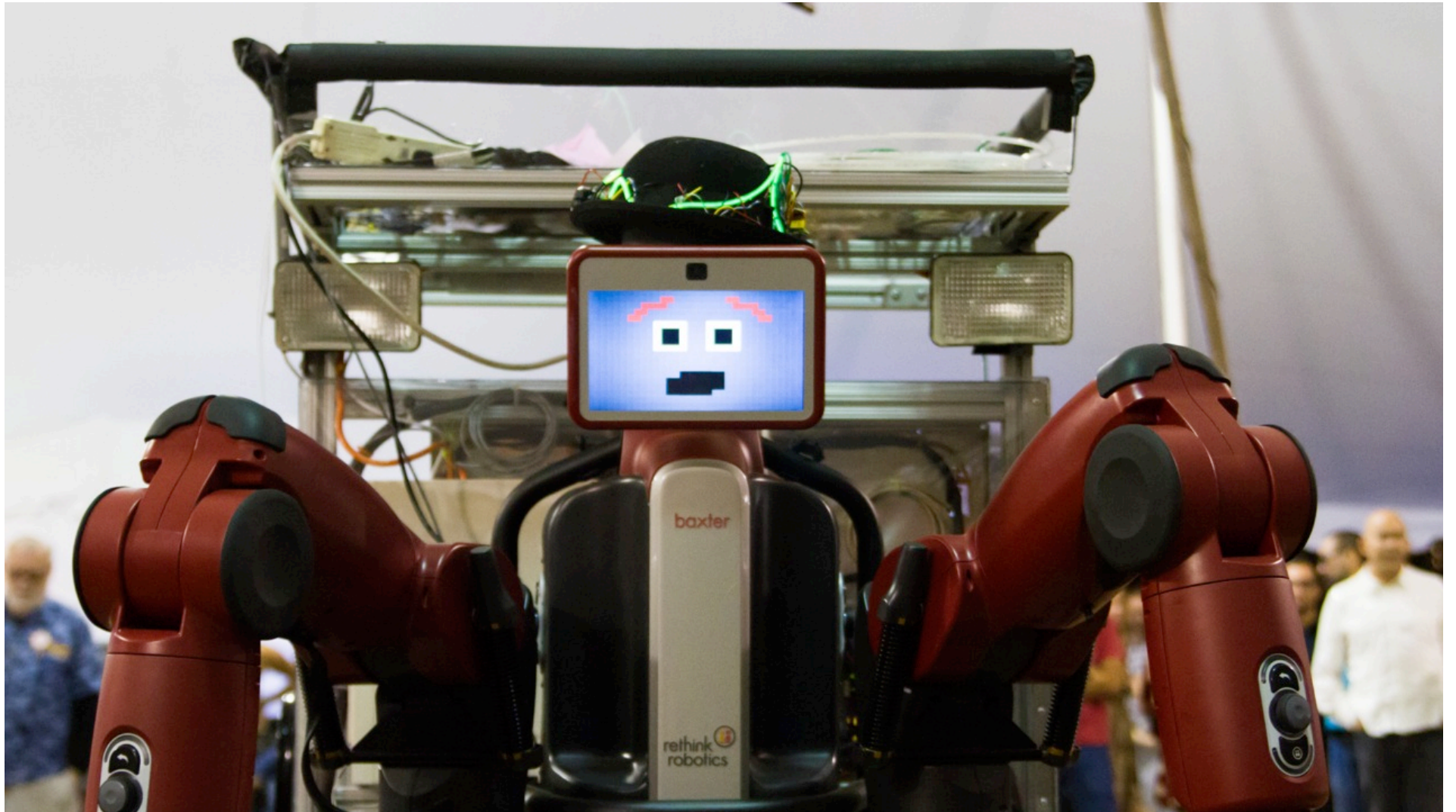
# Ars Robotic: general goals

- Produce creative and compelling performances for public outreach.









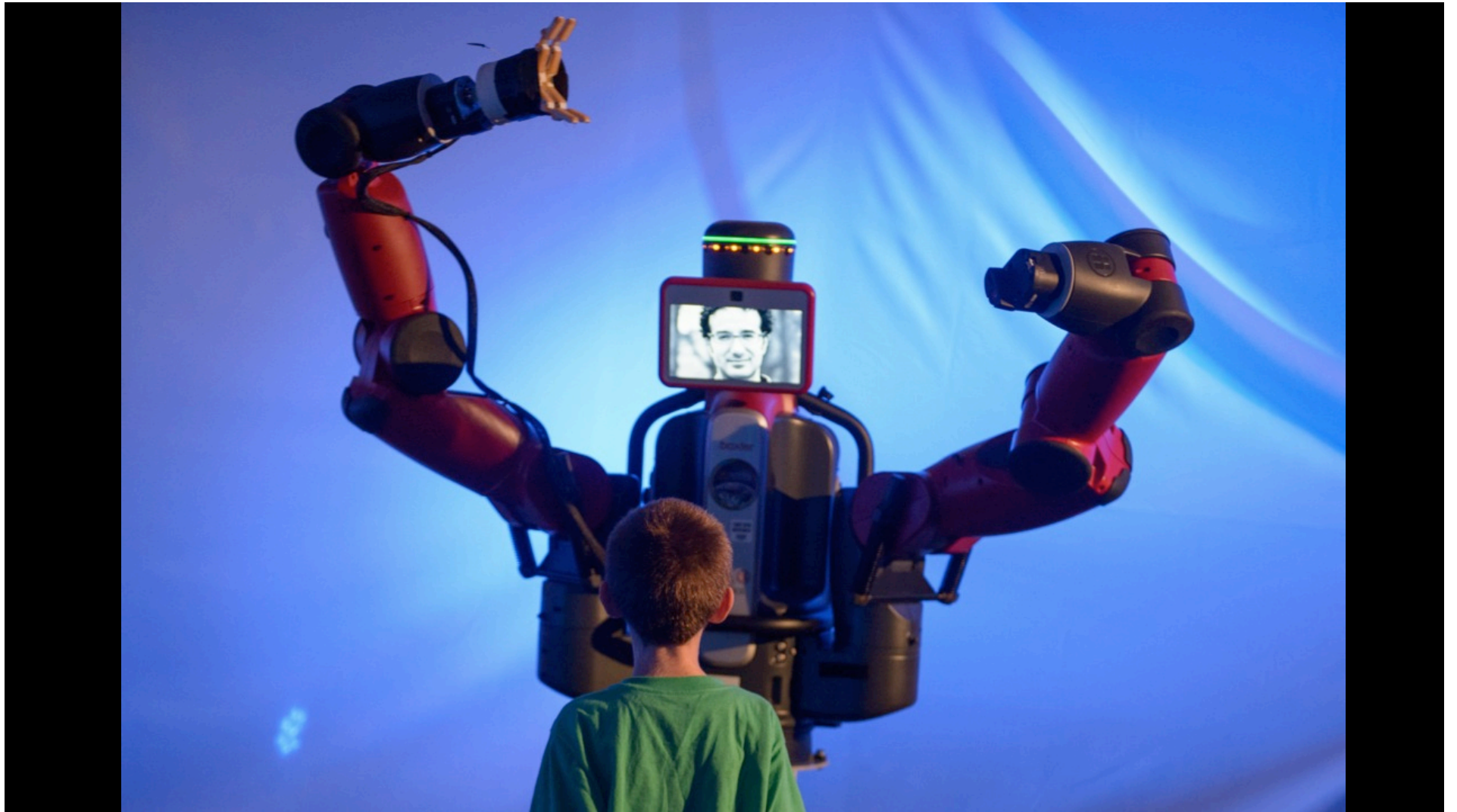

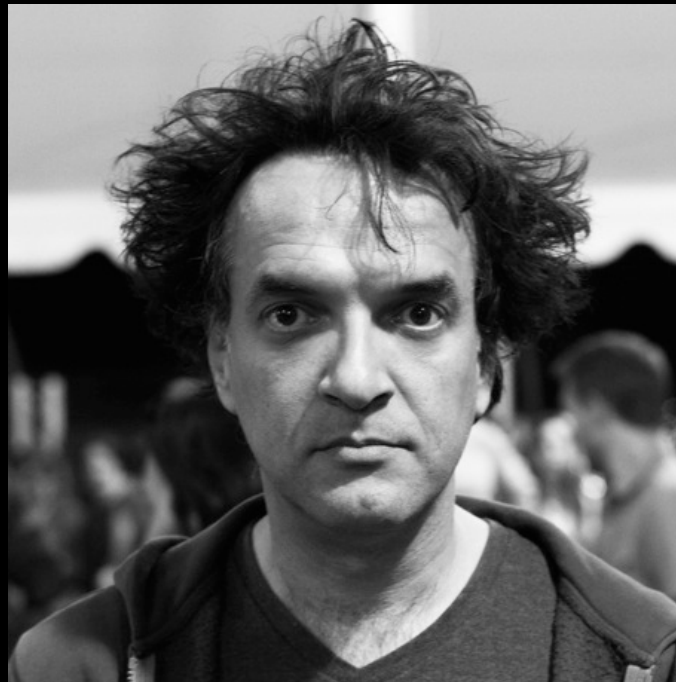

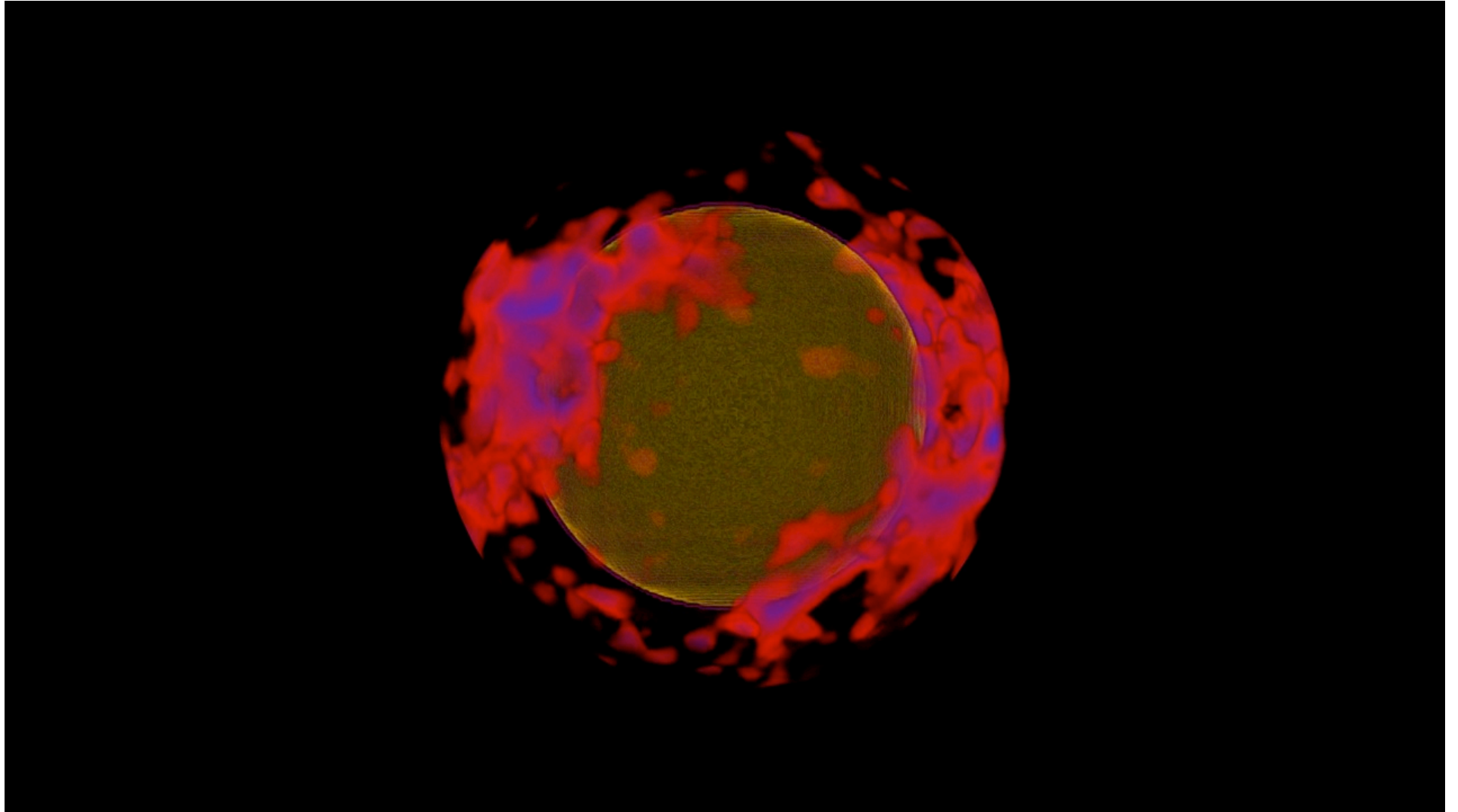
